

The Icelandic horse – a versatile partner with unique gaits.

The Icelandic horse is a robust and versatile breed that originates from the North Atlantic island of Iceland.

For over 1000 years, horses in Iceland have lived almost isolated from other breeds, which has contributed to their unique genetics and resilience. Despite their relatively small stature – with a height of about 130 to 145 cm – Icelandic horses are considered full-fledged horses and not ponies. Their strength, endurance, and friendly nature make them

popular riding horses for leisure, sport, and therapeutic riding.

Gaits

One of the most striking features of the Icelandic horse is its variety of gaits. In addition to the three basic gaits – walk, trot, and canter – many Icelandic horses master two additional

gaits: tölt and pace. The tölt is probably the gait that makes the Icelandic horse particularly popular. The tölt is a very comfortable four-beat gait in which the rider feels hardly any jolts. Tölt can be ridden at speeds ranging from working pace to racing pace. However, not every tölter masters the entire speed range. The flying pace is a fast gait in which the horse moves the legs on one side simultaneously forward. This gait is spectacular and is mainly shown in sports, as Icelandic horses can reach speeds of up to 50 km/h in the flying pace.

Colors

Icelandic horses come in an impressive variety of coat colors – far more than many other breeds. Over 100 color variations are known. Common colors include black, bay, chestnut, and gray. However, rarer colors such as palomino, dun, pinto, or even wind-colored also occur. Special features such as markings or multi-colored eyes occasionally appear. This colorful variety makes each Icelandic horse a true unique specimen.

Care

In terms of care, Icelandic horses are very frugal and adaptable – traits they bring from their harsh homeland. They are accustomed to living in groups and year-round open stable housing. A generous run, social contact with conspecifics, and appropriate feeding with plenty of roughage are particularly important for the well-being of an Icelandic horse.

Due to their dense winter coat, they prefer the outdoors even in bad weather or snow. They mainly seek the stable or shelter in extreme heat or when there is an influx of insects.

Please keep in mind...

- The World Championships for Icelandic Horses 2025 (WC 2025) is a cooperation between FEIF and the association 'Islandpferde-WM 2025 in der Schweiz' (VIS WM 2025).
 - The World Championships 2025 is an equestrian event. Participants in the sport competitions or breeding shows, as well as visitors, will come to the grounds voluntarily and at their own risk.
 - The sport and breeding events at the World Championships 2025 will be held under the auspices of FEIF and the rules for World Championships as outlined in the FEIF Rulebook Rules and Regulations.
 - Security: the organiser will take all reasonable measures to ensure the safety of all visitors, participants and horses. All individuals must consent to searches for personal protection and general security.
- During the World Championships 2025, it will be forbidden for participants, visitors, officials, and anyone present in any capacity to:**
- Communicate political views through banners or other means of public expression.
 - Behave aggressively or in a manner that may offend others;
 - Obstruct access or evacuation routes;
 - Distribute commercial merchandise or advertisements without prior approval from the organiser;
 - Bring pets (except for service dogs for people with disabilities), prams, buggies, loud radios, or other noise-producing devices into the stands;
 - Possess items that could reasonably be expected to cause danger or serious disruption. Such items will be confiscated immediately.
 - Drugs are prohibited on the grounds and will be confiscated. Alcohol is not allowed to anyone under the age of 16.
 - Parents are responsible for their children.
 - Clothing must be of a decent standard at all times.
 - By entering the grounds, you agree not to access restricted areas. You also agree to follow any instructions from the organisation, police, or other staff members.

You must occupy the seat indicated on your ticket and are not permitted to stand. Unless otherwise stated, Swiss law will apply.

- Violations of these regulations may result in removal from the premises, denial of further access to the event, and / or a CHF 50.- fine.
- By purchasing tickets for the World Championships 2025, you accept the rules as outlined here. When purchasing tickets for a group, you further agree to clearly communicate these rules to the members of your group.
- By purchasing tickets, you and those for whom you have purchased tickets also agree that any images taken of you during the event may be used, free of charge, for promotional materials related to the Icelandic horse or the World Championships 2025.
- The organiser and FEIF are not responsible or liable for any accidents, injuries, illnesses of participants, visitors, or officials, or for the loss or damage of personal belongings.
- FEIF, in cooperation with the organizer, has the right to change start and / or end times, places, or to cancel the World Championships 2025 in full or in part in case of extreme weather conditions, animal diseases or unforeseen disasters that cannot reasonably be addressed by the organisation. In these cases, there will be no refund of tickets.

- In case of doubt, disagreement, or situations not foreseen in these regulations, FEIF, in cooperation with the organiser, will make the final decision.
- Photography and filming are generally permitted for private purposes, provided that no flash is used. Professional photography or video recording requires the permission of the tournament management.
